Camping small talk

If you would like to look at the rules in detail, please find them below .

Arrival and departure

- We request that you visit reception upon your arrival. Please bring the registration number(s) of your vehicle(s).
- We would appreciate it if you could check out at reception when you leave at the end of your stay.

Car and other vehicles

- You will be issued with one barrier pass. This pass is personal and must not be handed on to others. This pass gives you access for one car;
- If you have booked a pitch with car, you may park the car at your pitch. If you have booked a pitch without car, or if the car does not fit on the pitch, you must park on the central parking. Parking is not permitted in front of Reception;
- Please take the maximum speed of 10 km/h into account. This ensures everyone's safety, especially that of playing children;
- Scooters and mopeds are not allowed on the campsite. They can be used on the stretch from the entry to Reception, where you'll find racks where these vehicles can be parked.

Camping pitch and means

- A maximum of 6 people may stay at any one camping pitch;
- We request you occupy the pitch you booked yourself. The person who booked this pitch is expected to stay at the pitch him/herself: subletting is not allowed;
- Should you receive overnight visitors, then they must be registered at Reception and the corresponding fees paid;
- Please make sure to leave your pitch tidy at the end of your stay. Rubbish needs to be placed in the appropriate rubbish containers;
- One main camping means only (caravan, campervan, tent or trailer tent) may be placed on the pitch, plus one additional small tent;
- Party tents are not allowed.

Hygiene and washrooms

- There are many underground rubbish containers on the campsite. Household rubbish, in sealed plastic rubbish bags, must be deposited here. In addition there are containers for the recycling of paper, glass, batteries and bulky waste;
- We kindly request children under 7 to be accompanied by an adult when they visit the washrooms;
- Access codes for disabled washrooms/ baby/ nursing rooms can be obtained from Reception;
- Cars may not be parked by the washrooms and/or toilet buildings;
- Our camping pitches are not connected to the sewer system. Toilet buckets may only be emptied in the appropriate receptacles in the washrooms (chemical toilet) by someone over the age of 12;
- We regret that it is not permitted to wash a car or a camping vehicle on the campsite;
- Washrooms and toilets may be used every day during camping opening times;
- It is forbidden to loiter or cause nuisance in or around the washrooms.

(Day) Visitors

- Should you receive visitors on the campsite, you may inform Reception and buy a visitor card. The price of a visitor card is €7.00 per day. Parking is available on the campsite's central parking. Note that parking in front of Reception is not permitted to exceed 15 minutes.

Access to the Nature Reserves

You have free access to the Kennemer Dunes from sun-up to sundown. Conditions for entry to the dunes are displayed at all entry points.

Additional camping ules:

We conclude with an outline of things we cannot permit:

- Open fires, with a view to fire prevention, are forbidden. Barbecuing is allowed on gas or electric only;
- Pets are not permitted, with the exception of recognizable guide dogs, hearing dogs or other working dogs;
- (Noise) nuisance: We request you respect other people's peace & quiet. Please make sure that you do not cause nuisance to your fellow guests. After 22.00 night time quiet is requested;
- The use of generators is not permitted. Abstracting electricity in every conceivable way is forbidden;
- We regret that it is not permitted to connect a garden hose to a tap;
- The possession, use of or trade in drugs is forbidden.
- It is not permitted to offer any merchandise;
- Rowdiness or the causing of nuisance as a consequence of inebriation after excessive use of alcohol and/or any drugs is strictly forbidden.

Should a member of staff call you to account then you must respond to his/her instructions immediately. The same applies to instructions from Emergency Response Officers, First Responders or other staff of Camping de Lakens.

Other Regulations: All agreements with Kennemer Duincampings are subject to Recron Conditions. All cases in which regulations are not provided for in these House Rules will be decided at the discretion of the Manager.
