- Alert Reception and describe the situation.

- Say:
  - Who you are
  - That an accident has happened
  - Where it happened
  - What has happened
  - How many victims there are
  - How you can be contacted

### EHBO (FIRST AID)

Several of our staff members are fully trained in company emergency first aid.  
There is also an Automatic External Defibrillator on site.

When you witness an emergency in the dunes please check the nearest sitting benches in the dunes. They are numbered. The emergency services will know where the accident has happened by the number on the nearest bench.

## WILDFIRE!

If the area you are in is threatened by wildfire, then:

- Mind your own safety
  - Phone 112
  - Alert Reception and describe the situation, AND the location.  
T. +31 6 51805249
  - Alert the people in the area
  - Help people who need extra help
  - Vacate the premises if necessary
  - Do NOT go to the fire
  - Follow instructions from staff and emergency personnel
-  During Red Flag conditions (see flag at Reception) all barbecues (also on electricity and gas) are prohibited as they constitute a wildfire hazard.

## EVACUATION!

If you are told to evacuate the area, then:

- Take with you: mobile telephone, medications,
- money and identity papers
- Check that your neighbours also leave and help them if necessary
- Leave your car and camping means behind
- Leave the place you are in
- Report to the assembly point
- Wait for further instructions
- In case of a toxic cloud, please stay in your caravan and close all windows and doors.
- Follow the instructions of staff and/or emergency personnel

## FIRE AT THE SITE!

- Make sure you are safe
- Phone 112
- Alert Reception and describe the situation, AND the location  
T. +31 6 – 51 80 52 49.
- Alert the people in the area
- If possible, extinguish the fire
- Provide help to people who need it
- Vacate the premises if necessary
- Follow instructions from staff and emergency personnel
