

Welcome at 'de Lakens'! We're really pleased to have you here! As we are here with lots of different people, it is important that we agree on a few rules; this will make everything as relaxed as possible for everyone.

If you would like to remind yourself of our full House Rules, you can do so below.

### **Arrival & Departure**

- When you report on arrival, we'd like to receive your vehicle registration number(s).
- We would like you to hand in the key to your rental accommodation when you leave. The barrier will automatically register that you left the campsite.

### **Car and other Vehicles**

- You will receive 1 (digital) barrier pass. This pass is personal and cannot be passed on. It will give you access for 1 car.
- If you booked a pitch with car, you may park your car at the pitch.
- If you have a pitch without car, or your car doesn't fit then you may park in the central car park.
- Parking in the arrival area in front of Reception is not allowed.
- We request you to adhere to the maximum speed of 10 km/hour to safeguard playing children.
- Scooters and mopeds are not allowed on the campsite and must be parked behind Reception.
- You may only charge your electric car at the designated charging points.

### **Camping Pitch and Camping Vehicle**

- A maximum of 6 people (2 adults, 4 children) may stay at one pitch.
- Camping is open for families with children or couples from 21 years of age. Regrettably we do not allow groups.
- Pets are not allowed, with the exception of certified assistance dogs. We ask you to inform Reception if you intend to bring your assistance dog.
- You are required to occupy the pitch in person. The person who made the booking must be camping, as subletting is not allowed.
- When receiving staying guests at the campsite, these need to be registered and the appropriate fees paid.
- At the end of your stay the pitch should be left in a neat and clean state. Please put all rubbish in the appropriate bins.
- One main camping vehicle may be placed on the pitch (touring caravan, folding caravan, campervan or tent). One small additional tent is allowed.
- Party tents are not allowed.
- Paddling pools are not allowed

### **Visitors**

- Will you be receiving guests who will arrive by car? Or are you just visiting restaurant Gestrand? Please ask at Reception about available parking space on the central car park. If we have space available you can buy Day Parking. If we don't have space, you'll have to find car parking space somewhere outside of the campsite premises.
- Parking in the arrival area is for 1st time arriving guests only, and is for a maximum of 15 minutes.
- Visitors of restaurant Gestrand, the Bicycle rental, sports lessons or the Wellness Bus also need to purchase a Day Parking card.

### **Hygiene and Washrooms**

- There are ample underground waste containers at the campsite. You can deposit your general household waste here, tied up in bin bags. We also have containers for paper, glass, batteries and large items.
- We very much appreciate an adult accompanying children under 7 visiting the washrooms.
- Access codes to the disabled and family areas of the washrooms are available from Reception.
- Parking near the washrooms or toilets is not allowed.
- Our pitches are not connected to the main sewers, and the use of a flushing toilet on the pitch or in the camping vehicle is therefore not allowed. Toilet buckets may only be emptied at the designated places in the washrooms (chemical toilet), and only by a person of 12 years or older.
- It is not allowed to wash your car or camping vehicle on the campsite.
- It is not allowed to cause a nuisance or lounge around in, on, or around the washrooms.
- The use of cameras and/or recording equipment in the washrooms and sauna is forbidden.

### **Access to the surrounding natural area**

- You'll have free access to the Kennemerduinen from sun up to sun down. All entrance points in the dunes display the full conditions for entry.

### **Additional Camping Rules**

- Fire precautions dictate that all open fire is forbidden.
- Barbecuing is only allowed when using gas or electricity.
- We request that you do not feed the animals in the natural area or on the campsite.
- We request everyone to respect the peace and quiet at the campsite. No noise after 22:00.
- The use of generators is not allowed. It is also not allowed to siphon off electricity in any way.
- It is not allowed to connect a hose to any taps or water points.
- The possession, use or sale of drugs is forbidden.
- It is not allowed to offer any merchandise.
- The use of a drone on the campsite is not allowed.

When a member of staff addresses you about your behaviour, you must follow any instructions without delay. This also applies to directions or orders from First Aid workers (evacuation), other aid workers or staff of Camping de Lakens.

Other provisions: All agreements with Kennemer Duincampings are subject to RECRON conditions. In cases where these do not bring a resolution, the manager will decide.
